Title: Han-Modular(R) Surge Protection Modules

We would like to announce the new Surge Protection Modules in Han-Modular[®].

Background

The transmission quality of signals from measuring, control and regulation technology depends both on the connector used as well as on the presence of protective devices within signal circuits. In order to save space, time and finally costs, miniaturization and modularization plays an important role.

For this reasons, HARTING developed together with the company DEHN + SÖHNE a surge protection module for sensitive control eqipment which fits in a rectangular connector.

Two different versions of the module protect different control signals like analogue signals, digital signals and within limits differential signals from bus applications.

The application of surge protection modules reduces the number of operating faults, increase the life of the production line and ultimately increase system availability.

The surge protection modules work inly as combination of socket + plug module

Type 1 - Han-Modular® SP SO DM2 (Socket) + Han-Modular® SP PL DM2 (Plug)

Differential Mode



- Surge protection for two pairs of balanced signals
- Protects symmetric signals interfaces with electrical isolation
- Fits in a Han-Modular® connector system
- Nominal voltage: 24VDC
- Nominal current: max. 0.5A

Type 2 - Han-Modular® SP SO CM4 (Socket) + Han-Modular® SP PL CM4 (Plug)

Common Mode



- Surge protection for four single lines
- Protects signals with common ground
- Fits in a Han-Modular® connector system
- Nominal voltage: 24VDC
- Nominal current: max. 0.5A








Grounding concept




The hinged frame must be conencted with an earting cable >6mm² resp. <AWG10
