

The psychology of colours

Colours play an important role when it comes to safety signs: they convey a message - and each safety colour has a specific meaning.

The colour of the sign specifies the nature of the sign: red signs are prohibitive; blue signs are mandatory; yellow signs are warnings; and green is used for safe condition and first aid signs.

Similar rules apply to the different shapes: prohibitive and obligatory signs are circular: warning signs are trianglar; and oblong signs offer help and directions. All Brady signs meet these requirements concerning colour and shape.
