



Internal Resistance:

The internal resistance of the cell varies with state of charge, as follows:

Cell Charged
30 milliohms
(tolerance of ±20% applies to above values)

AC Impedance (no load):

The impedance of the charged cell varies with frequency, as follows:

Frequency (Hz) Impedance (milliohms) (charged cell)

Above values based on AC current set at 1.0 ampere. Value tolerances are $\pm 20\%$.

Operating and Storage Temperatures:

To maintain maximum performance, observe the following general guidelines regarding environmental conditions:

Charge: 0°C to 40°C (32°F to 104°F)
Discharge: 0°C to 50°C (32°F to 122°F)
Storage: -20°C to 30°C (-4°F to 86°F)

Humidity: 65±20%

NOTE: Operating at extreme temperatures, will significantly impact battery cycle life.
